Early Years, Early Help EYEH Team

The Early Years, Early Help (**EYEH**) team support families to establish and enhance skills that better enable them to help their child meet their developmental milestones. Encouraging families to engage and promote their child's play, language and holistic development.

EYEH will

- support and scaffold learning, knowledge, skills and understanding of the early years, playwork and childcare sector as part of the early years pathway and be able to deliver a range of services and opportunities for children aged 0 - 11 years of age.
- Deliver evidence-based programmes, practice, play opportunities and interventions as well as whole family approaches, via open access play sessions, group and one to one work.
- support and deliver provision for children with emerging or diagnosed disabilities

The aim is to give all parents the "best possible support" and make sure those that need extra help get it at an early stage.
